The new CLUBMASTER ICONIC: a classic revisited with elegance

Since 2013, **BRISTON** has imposed its particular style by giving their watches a « Sport Chic » touch with a watchmaker DNA. Launched in September, and following the success of its first automatic diving watch, the brand has decided to complete its Clubmaster collection by launching the Clubmaster ICONIC.

The Clubmaster ICONIC is characterized by this cambered-square, or cushion, shape. This continuity of the Clubmaster design counts considerably for its impregnation in the collective memory, as well as in the unconscious of the watches connoisseurs, who associate this shape with the brand. The Clubmaster ICONIC can only become an icon if it's identifiable at first sight, regardless of its generation.

With an elegant discretion, displaying a 40mm shape, applied indexes, a subtly imbedded bevel-cut opening at 6 o'clock; not to mention the transparent case-back, giving an unobstructed view of the automatic movement, the Clubmaster ICONIC is conceived to be a timeless classic in the Clubmaster collection: a true symbol of the excellence and the commitment of the brand to the watchmaking tradition.

The cambered square shape of the case, made of cellulose acetate or in polished steel, features a new and ultra-resistant sapphire glass, offering an impregnable view on the time. Thanks to the transparent case back, this new case enables to admire the automatic movement, endowed with a « Côte de Genève » decorated rotor.

The elegant dials in silvery-white, or black, feature Dauphine-styled arrow-shaped polished applied indexes. A particular attention has been granted to the white-dialed versions which displays a central second hand in blued steel.

As for the movement, this new collection is composed of two new models, a classic version driven by a NH35 Japanese automatic movement, proof of reliability and precision, and a more contemporary version, which encloses the NH38 automatic movement, with an opening on the balance wheel at 9 o'clock.

Lastly, BRISTON has chosen to present the Clubmaster ICONIC on some new two-part straps, in aged leather. Especially developed for this new model, they are endowed with a spring system allowing to easily change the strap and to keep the characteristic interchangeability of the brand. These straps reinforce this new watch's elegant sobriety and illustrate this new collection's classic spirit.
